


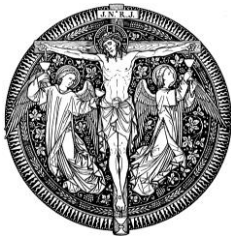

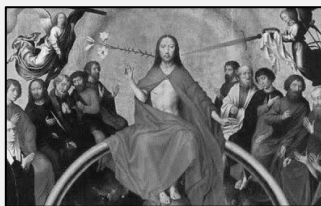

St. Benedict advises in his Holy Rule that we must "keep death ever before our eyes". What is death, and what do we believe about the life to come? The way that we approach and answer questions about death largely determines our life on this earth, and in the eternity which follows. Taking into account the importance of these

questions, our adult catechesis of four weeks will look at "Eschatology", or what is more commonly known as "the four last things": Death, Judgment, Hell, and Heaven.

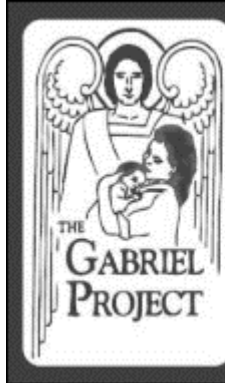


