St Stephen parishioners supply 240 lunches a month to help them feed the homeless in Sacramento and they are very grateful for this help! On **Sun., Sept. 29**, St. Stephen's Society of St. Vincent de Paul will be sponsoring a **food drive** before and after the 8:00, 10:30, and 1:30 Masses to replenish our food pantry. We will be collecting the following types of food in the courtyard (all food must be non-perishable):

Tuna or chicken lunch packs, pouches, or pull-tab cans (single serving). Apple sauce cups or fruit cups. Chips or peanut butter crackers/cheese crackers. Desserts, like cookies. Jars of peanut butter, jelly or preserves.

Cash donations will also be accepted. You may also sign up to be a regular donor. If you cannot make it to one of the above Masses, food may be dropped off in the black box under the bulletin table in the vestibule.

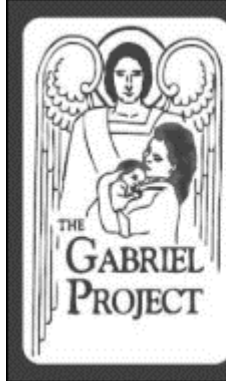
