St. Stephen's was the final stop on the Missive's summer California tour, and that weekend the busy parish was holding its biggest event of the year – the annual Pig Roast in honor of its patron saint.

One of the older parishes in the Fraternity, St. Stephen's was founded in 1997 and worked out of the parishes of St. Rose and Immaculate Conception before purchasing its own church in 2002. The church was a former Lutheran building that required almost \$2 million in initial renovations.

Do please continue to remain after Mass for these important prayers if at all possible. I'm very grateful to parents explaining to their children the value of these prayers and keeping them in Church until after they are said. Please continue to pray for vocations at home, as well!


