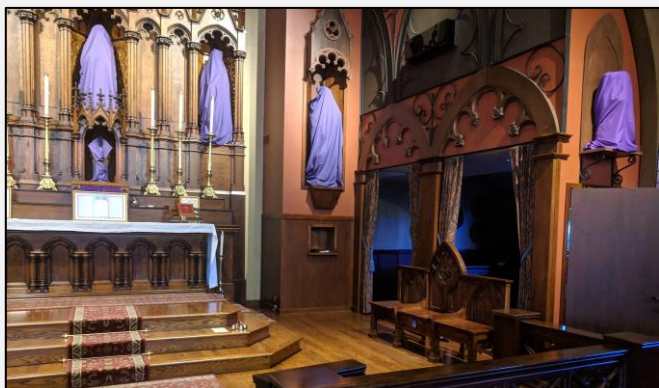

Arrival of the Sedilia

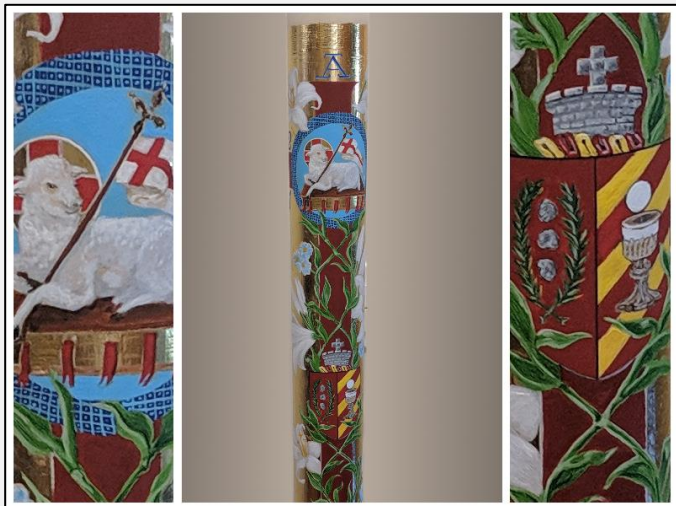
In honor of Fr. John Lyons, FSSP

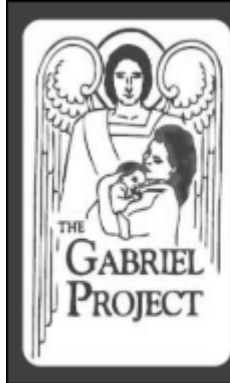
