PASTOR'S COLUMN

The great O Antiphons begin Friday, December 17: *O Sapientia* (Wisdom), *O Adonai* (Lord), *O Radix Jesse* (Root of Jesse), *O Clavis David* (Key of David), *O Oriens* (Dayspring), *O Rex Gentium* (King of the Nations), *O Emmanuel* (With Us is God). These ancient vesperal antiphons, which continue until Christmas eve, spell out in reverse by their first letters: *Ero cras*, that is, *tomorrow*, *I will be*.

Registrations for classes for **First Holy Communion** continue to be available. Forms will be due <u>NEXT WEEK</u>, Sun, Dec 19. Classes will begin Sun, Jan 9 at 2:30 pm.

Offertory envelopes for 2022 will be available starting Sun, Dec 12, in the room between the office and bookstore.

The bookstore is now taking orders for **candles** to be blessed on the Feast of the Purification, on Feb 2. Order early to ensure that they will arrive on time. Beeswax and other devotional candles are available. All orders must be in by Wed, Jan 5.

The **Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe**, which usually falls on Dec 12, is a first class feast on account of her patronage of the diocese. Since Dec 12 falls on a Sunday this year, the *feast will be transferred to Mon, Dec 13*. There will be a sung Mass on Mon, Dec 13 at 6 pm.

However! In honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe, we will have a **procession** after the confirmation class around the property of St. Stephen's, around 4 pm, on Sun, Dec 12. Hymn sheets will be provided for those who want to sing as we process.

The **Chesterton Society** will meet on Tues, Dec 14, at 7 pm. They will be discussing the last chapter of *Orthodoxy*, "Authority and the Adventurer".

The men's **Holy League** will meet on Wed, Dec 15. A Holy Hour is made after the 6 pm Mass, followed by a talk by one of the priests and then food and social. No invitation necessary.

Seniors (60+) are invited to lunch in classroom 1 after the noon Mass on Thurs, Dec 16.

Christmas Eve. There will be Masses held at 7:00 am and 12:00 pm. The usual Friday 6:00 pm Mass is cancelled. At 9:30 pm, Christmas Matins will be sung by the priests and choir. All are encouraged to attend; Latin-English booklets will be available.

Octave Day of Christmas. Jan 1. Since it falls on a Saturday, the obligation is dispensed. Masses at 7 am, 8:30 am, and 12 pm (Sung).
