SECURITY CONCERNS

I do not anticipate Roe v Wade protests affecting our parish, but I do encourage parishioners to maintain situational awareness, and to exercise due caution and prudence, especially this Sunday and in the weeks to come. In addition to other security measures that we are planning, we will be beginning to lock the campus up at 8 pm every night, unless some parish event or activity is taking place.
