PASTOR'S COLUMN

FINDING OF THE RELICS OF ST STEPHEN

The discovery of the relics of St Stephen was one of the most magnificent chapters in the history of the early Church. St. Augustine, who heard of and witnessed many miracles in the presence of these relics, was not able even to record all of them: "What am I to do? I am so pressed by the promise of finishing this work that I cannot record all the miracles I know." Our patronal feast, which recalls the finding of these relics, falls this Wednesday, August 3. Please consider attending Mass in honor of our patron!

(NB. The afternoon Mass that will begin the Pig Roast on Saturday will a Mass of the Finding of the Relics, as well, by dispensation from our bishop, who extended that to us in light of our parish festival.)
