#### **COMPLINE**

The priests will be praying Compline, the night hour of the Divine Office, on weekday evenings at 7:40 pm during Advent. Faithful are welcome to be present but we ask that they only join in for the Marian antiphon, which is sung at the conclusion of the prayers (the last time we tried this we encouraged everyone to sing the psalms and other prayers but it was a bit of a disaster).

As Compline will require at least two priests, it may be cancelled on certain days without advance notice on account of events, illness, or other unforeseen circumstances.
