PASTOR'S COLUMN

THE DIVINE OFFICE

As Advent approaches, I invite anyone considering taking on additional spiritual practices to try praying the Divine Office. The Office is the official prayer of the Church, united to and flowing from the Mass. There are eight canonical "hours" every day:

Of these, Lauds and Vespers are the "major" hours; Prime, Terce, Sext, None, and Compline are considered "minor" hours. Priests and religious are generally bound to the daily recitation of all the canonical hours, but the faithful who wish to pray the Divine Office can pray any or all of the hours according to their opportunity and desire. For those just getting started, I might recommend praying *either*: Lauds & Vespers (i.e. the major hours); *or* Prime & Compline.

The greater part of the Divine Office is composed of the Psalms, all of which are prayed over the course of every week. Added to them, at every hour, are certain hymns, canticles, prayers, and readings from the Sacred Scriptures. Given the prominence of the Psalms in the Divine Office, it can be very helpful to read commentaries on them in conjunction with praying them. Christological explanations are the best and most meaningful.

The faithful are welcome to pray the Divine Office from a breviary translated into English, or from the original Latin, according to their ability. There are Latin-English *Diurnales* available, which have all the prayers for the entire year in a single volume, excluding only Matins. There are also several online resources available; the easiest to access is probably <code>www.divinumofficium.com</code>, which will give you the entire day's Office, in both Latin and English, on your phone or other electronic device.
