Vigil of Christmas (Sun, Dec 24). Normal Sunday schedule (i.e. 7 am, 8:30 am, 10 am, 11:30 am, 1 pm, and 6 pm). Matins begins at 9:30 pm. *NB*: <u>No catechism classes Dec 24 or Dec 31</u>.

Christmas (Mon, Dec 25). Masses at:

- Midnight (Solemn); Matins starts at 9:30 pm
- 7 am (confessions beforehand as usual)
- 8:30 am
- 10 am
- 11:30 am
- 1 pm (Sung)
- Please note there is no 6 pm Mass.

Feast of St. Stephen (Dec 26). Masses at 7 am, noon, and – at 6 pm – a Solemn Mass with Guild Ceremony. Reception for members of the Guild to follow in the parish hall.

Octave of Christmas (Jan 1). As it falls on a Monday, this is not a Holy Day of Obligation; normal Monday schedule.
