CHRISTMAS BLESSINGS & THANK YOU

On behalf of the priests and staff of St. Stephen the First Martyr, I wish a blessed Christmastide to our parishioners. The priests would like to express their warm gratitude for the Christmas cards and gifts received from parishioners. I would also like to thank the many volunteers – members of the altar guild, of the choir, decorators, and others – who made helped make Christmas beautiful for all the parish this year.

JANUARY SCHEDULE

Mon, Jan 1: Normal schedule; not a Holy Day of Obligation.

Tues, Jan 2: Masses at 7am, noon & 6 pm.

Wed, Jan 3: Mass at noon.

Thurs, Jan 4: Masses at noon & 6 pm.

Fri, Jan 5: Mass at noon. Water blessing follows Mass.

EPIPHANY WATER BLESSING

The Epiphany water blessing will be held on Fri, Jan 5, after the noon Mass, in the Church. Some notes, please read carefully:

- Water containers must be at least one gallon in size.
- Containers must be clearly labelled.
- Limit of two containers.

This blessed water should foster a real devotion to the mysteries of Epiphany, namely: the visit of the Magi, the baptism of Our Lord, and the first miracle of Our Lord – the changing of water into wine. Use it with devotion throughout the year to petition Our Lord's presence and protection be made manifest. And do please make every effort to attend Mass on Epiphany!

EPIPHANY PROCLAMATION

Know, dear brethren, that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior.

On the **fourteenth day of February** will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season.

On the **thirty-first day of March** you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the **ninth day of May** will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the **nineteenth day of May**, the feast of Pentecost.

On the **second day of June**, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

On the **first day of December**, the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

EPIPHANY CHALK

Blessed chalk will be available in the vestibule from the Feast of Epiphany (this Saturday). Upon returning home, the lintel of the main door of the house is marked with the blessed chalk by the head of the household in the following manner.

Inscribe **20+C+M+B+24** *while saying the following prayer:*

The Three Wise Men ...

C Caspar,

M Melchior,

B & Balthasaar,

followed the star of God's Son who became Man,

20 Two-thousand,

and twenty-four years ago.

+ May Christ,

+ bless our home,

and remain with us,

+ through the new year.

Almighty God, incline Thine ear. Bless us and all who are gathered here. Send Thy holy angel who will defend us, and fill with grace all who dwell here. Amen.
