# ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE & GIFT CARD SCAMS

A few days ago, I watched the newly-elected president of Argentina give a speech to the World Economic Forum. It was a decent speech, and, considering the context, perhaps even a brave speech. But the more of interest was that the speech was delivered in English: a language which the president does not speak.

Artificial "intelligence" (AI) had removed the original Spanish and imposed a spoken English translation, while maintaining the president's voice in pitch, timbre, tone, and cadence. His lips were seamlessly synced to the English translation. Had I been unaware that the president does not speak English, I never would have realized that the speech was, in a sense, a fake (the translation in this case was at least accurate).

A couple of weeks ago, the other priests and I watched a pilot program of an AI news channel which is being proposed for the Los Angeles area. All of the anchors were generated by AI. Again, had we been unaware that the anchors were not real people, we very likely could have been convinced otherwise.

These sorts of phenomena are improving at an accelerating pace. It was only about six months ago that AI generated images could not quite get hands right; there would almost always be too many fingers, or too few, or too many joints, or hands bent in ways beyond normal thresholds. That this technology has progressed so far, in so short a time, is alarming to say the least.

In the future, we will likely have to be on our guard against all sorts of dangers, which now we can only imagine. It is possible we are looking at a paradigm shift as sweeping and dramatic as the smartphone or the internet. Time will tell.

For now, I want to renew my warning against scams that are becoming increasingly common. It seems that criminals are getting better at identifying parishioners of St. Stephen's. It used to be that only those parishioners that were in the bulletin – whether in the volunteer groups listed on the opposite page, or in the announcements, or in the ads on the back – were being targeted by these scams. But the scammers have broadened their net. I am not sure what mechanism they are using, but it is getting increasingly easier for bots to farm data from what is publicly available on the internet. A facial recognition algorithm running over a social media post would be enough to identify persons and place them at St. Stephen's, allowing a bot to guess that someone is probably a parishioner.

These scams, which to present have been limited to texts and e-mail, are very probably going to get much more sophisticated, and soon. It is already trivial to run speech through a voice filter, which means that getting a call from an AI that sounds like Fr. Curtis or one of the other priests, is already within the realm of possibility.

The priests will <u>never</u> ask for gift cards, or for private bank information, or other such things, and especially never by text, e-mail, phone, or any electronic means.

For reference, this has been the general playbook for these scammers:

**Scammer**: *Hi, this is Fr Curtis, please let me know if you can help with an urgent situation.* 

**Parishioner**: Of course I can help. What do you need?

**Scammer**: I'm at the hospital with a little girl dying of cancer. I want to help her take her mind off things but I left my wallet at home. Can you purchase a couple of \$100 iTunes cards and send me the registration numbers on them? That way she can at least watch a few movies.

It's pretty twisted. Be on your guard.
