PASTOR'S COLUMN FUNDRAISER FOR KIANA NAVA

Note from Fr. Curtis: Kiana has recently moved to San Diego, because she found good employment there and was also able to reduce her expenses there. She is currently attending our FSSP parish, St. Anne's. Recently she has partnered with the Labouré Society, a well established ministry that helps young people raise money in order to pay off college debt to facilitate entry into religious life. Some FSSP seminarians have used Labouré in order to expedite their entry into seminary.

I invited Kiana to write something for the bulletin to share some details about her fundraising process. There are links included below with further information, and we are also hosting an informational booth this Sunday. If you are looking for a place to give alms this Lent, this would be a worthy consideration. Thank you. (The following is written by Kiana in collaboration with the Labouré Society.)

Every year, thousands of priestly and religious vocations are unable to answer God's call for one simple reason, outstanding student loans. It may come as a surprise, but nearly half of the estimated 10,000 individuals discerning a vocation in the US each year are prevented from entering seminaries and religious institutions for financial reasons. Most people today graduate from college carrying heavy fiscal burdens; unfortunately, dioceses and orders, desperately in need of new vocations but already stretched to the limit, are unable to assume their debt.

Our own Kiana Nava is one such vocation. She discovered St. Stephen's while studying at UC Davis and had been a parishioner here since 2021. Shortly after becoming a part of our parish community, she began discerning religious life and eventually came to the realization that God was calling her to enter the cloister. After graduating from UC Davis, she was accepted to join the Benedictines of Mary, Queen of Apostles, in Ava Missouri, this coming fall. Unfortunately, her studies at the university left her with student loan debt that must be paid before she is allowed to enter into formation.

To overcome this obstacle the Benedictines and Kiana have partnered with the **Labouré Society**, a Catholic 501(c)(3) nonprofit. She has a goal of raising \$60,000 by June 30th.
