PASTOR'S COLUMN HOLY WEEK

Palm Sunday. Normal Sunday schedule, but the High Mass includes the blessing of palms and a procession. The Passion according to St. Matthew.

• **1 pm**: Solemn Mass with blessing of the palms and procession.

Palm Sunday honors Our Lord's kingship in the procession of the Holy Cross and in the proclamation of his Sacred Passion, during which the faithful hold aloft blessed palms, recognizing thereby Our Lord's victory in his Paschal mysteries. The palms enjoy one of the longest sacramental blessings of any blessed item and are one of the few sacred items blessed in the context of the Mass itself. The faithful carry them home and place them with devotion behind the crucifix – a perpetual reminder that Our Lord "reigns from the wood."

For those attending earlier Masses on Palm Sunday, palms will be available throughout the rest of Holy Week.

Monday to Wednesday. Normal daily Mass schedule.

- **Monday**. The Gospel is taken from St. John, ch. 12; *Let her alone, that she may keep it against the day of my burial*.
- **Tuesday**. The Passion according to St. Mark.
- Wednesday. The Passion according to St. Luke.

Holy Thursday.

- 8 am: Matins and Lauds, i.e. *Tenebrae*.
- 11:30 am: Confessions.
- 6 pm: Solemn Mass with procession to the Altar of Repose; stripping of the altars; Vespers; overnight vigil.

Holy Thursday recalls the institution of the Holy Eucharist and the Priesthood, as well as Our Lord's agony in the garden. The faithful are invited after Mass to "spend one hour" with him. The Altar of Repose will be available all night and into the Mass of the Pre-Sanctified on Friday. Men from the security team will keep watch over the property overnight to maintain a safe environment for those coming to visit Our Lord.

The Mass of the Last Supper is connected to the Mass of the Pre-Sanctified of the following day by the vigil that joins them, as well as the processions to (on Holy Thursday) and from (on Good Friday) the Altar of Repose. This is one of many elements during Holy Week that unite Our Lord's Passion to his gift of the Holy Eucharist.

Good Friday.

- 8 am: Matins and Lauds, i.e. *Tenebrae*.
- 11:30 am: Confessions.
- **12 pm**: Stations of the Cross.
- **1 pm**: Mass of the Pre-Sanctified. The Passion according to St. John. A collection for the Holy Land is taken up.

Good Friday commemorates the Passion & Death of Our Lord. Holy Communion is not received on this day as the faithful enter into the mystery of the loss of Our Lord at his death. Vigil of Easter.

- 8 am: Preparatory rites for adult converts.
- 4 pm: Mass of the Vigil of Easter.

On Holy Saturday we keep vigil at the tomb of Our Lord, with the same sentiments of sorrow and hope embraced by Our Lady as she awaited the Resurrection. The Mass includes the blessing of the Paschal fire and trident-led procession in the Church, followed by the Exsultet, one of the most sublime works of poetry adorning the holy liturgy, then twelve lessons recalling salvation history, the blessing of Paschal water and the reception of converts, the Litany of the Saints, and finally the Mass proper. The propers of the Mass elicit both penitential sorrow and an anticipated joy.

Easter Sunday. Normal Sunday schedule. Solemn Mass at 1 pm.
