PASTOR'S COLUMN

CAMPS SACRED HEART & IMMACULATE HEART

These camps are scheduled for Jun 16 to 22 (Sun to Sat), and Jun 22 to Jun 28 (Sat to Fri), respectively. Camp Sacred Heart is for the boys, whereas Camp Immaculate Heart will be for the girls. Please note the dates on your calendars. The dates are arranged such that families that have both boys and girls attending will be able to pick up the boys on Sat, Jun 17 and at the same time drop off the girls.

Ages for both camps: 10 - 18. A nine year old may be considered for Camp Sacred Heart, space permitting and if accompanied by his father.

Sisters & Seminarians: We will have seminarians for Camp Sacred Heart and four sisters from the FLM community at Camp Immaculate Heart.

Cost: The camp will be \$250 for the first child in a family, \$200 for the second, \$150 for the third, etc. Scholarships will be available for families for whom the registration fee constitutes a financial burden.

Registration: Available in the parish bookstore and office. Please get your registrations in early to secure a spot on the camp! They will be due on <u>Sun, May 26</u>.

DIOCESAN BANKRUPTCY

Update from His Excellency Jaime Soto, Bishop of Sacramento

Last December I shared with you my decision to file a Chapter 11 petition with the United States Bankruptcy Court on behalf of the administrative offices of the Diocese of Sacramento. I will file that petition on Monday, April 1, 2024.

As I shared in the December announcement, the bankruptcy process is the only respectful, and equitable way to address the substantial number of claims by those who have been abused by clergy and other Church Workers. Bankruptcy is a lengthy process, but it provides supervision and transparency for all the parties involved so that an equitable resolution is offered to the victim-survivors of abuse. The court-supervised reorganization will also allow me to sustain the sanctifying, teaching, and charitable work of the Catholic community in Northern California.

The Diocese is creating an easily accessible Chapter 11 Bankruptcy page on its website. On this page you will find all communications from the diocese pertaining to bankruptcy, the latest FAQs, as well as all court filings and documentation.

As this journey of atonement continues, join me in prayer for all the victim-survivors of abuse. May the Lord of mercies also renew us in our commitment to be the disciples of Jesus. Only by God's grace will we emerge from this penitential exercise with greater resolve to be a humble sanctuary of holiness and healing for all the sons and daughters of God in Northern California.
