CAMPS SACRED HEART & IMMACULATE HEART

These camps are scheduled for Jun 16 to 22 (Sun to Sat), and Jun 22 to Jun 28 (Sat to Fri), respectively. Camp Sacred Heart is for the boys, whereas Camp Immaculate Heart will be for the girls. Please note the dates on your calendars. The dates are arranged such that families that have both boys and girls attending will be able to pick up the boys on Sat, Jun 17 and at the same time drop off the girls.

Ages for both camps: 10 - 18. A nine-year old may be considered for Camp Sacred Heart, space permitting and if accompanied by his father.

Sisters & Seminarians: We will have seminarians for Camp Sacred Heart and four sisters from the FLM community at Camp Immaculate Heart.

Cost: The camp will be \$250 for the first child in a family, \$200 for the second, \$150 for the third, etc. Scholarships will be available for families for whom the registration fee constitutes a financial burden.
