FIRST AID CABINETS

We installed first aid cabinets throughout the property. Eventually each one will be stocked with a bleed kit (which includes a tourniquet) and a first aid kit. They are large orange metal cabinets with a first aid decal on the front, so they are highly visible and hard to miss. They are located in the following locations:

- Vestibule
- Parish Hall, behind the curtain, near the AV inputs
- Kitchen, by the sink (this one will be installed in a couple of weeks; we were lacking a drill bit for tile)
- Parish Office, across from the coffee station
- Classroom Office
- Classroom 1
- Classroom 2
- Classroom 3
- Classroom 4
- Rectory Porch (this one is located outside, so even if all the classrooms are locked, an adult should be able to get access to this)



I am also working on getting a couple of AED units for the parish. When they arrive, I am thinking to install one in the vestibule near the first aid kit, and the other one in the classroom office.

If you use something from a first aid cabinet, please inform one of the priests or someone on the parish staff, so that we can get it replaced as soon as possible.
