INDULGENCES FOR THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED

There are many indulgences, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, that can be obtained during the month of November. From the fourth edition of the *Enchiridion of Indulgences*, 1999:

A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in purgatory, is granted to the faithful who,

- on any and each day from November 1 to 8, devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, if only mentally, for the departed;
- on All Souls' Day, devoutly visit a church or an oratory and recite an *Our Father* and the *Creed*.

A partial indulgence, applicable only to the souls in purgatory, is granted to the faithful who,

- devoutly visit a cemetery and at least mentally pray for the dead;
- devoutly recite lauds or vespers from the Office of the Dead or the prayer *Requiem aeternam* (Eternal rest).

This Week

The All Souls Novena will continue with the public Masses of Mon, Nov 5 & Tues, Nov 6.

Election Day: Tues, Nov 5.

On Wed, Nov 6, Masses for the departed members of the Fraternity and Confraternity of Saint Peter will be offered at all public Masses. This is in accordance with the Constitutions of the FSSP, which state: "On November 5th of each year the priests of the FSSP will celebrate a Requiem mass for all the deceased members of the Fraternity and the Confraternity. If November 5th falls on a Sunday or if the priest is detained, this mass will be celebrated the next day or as soon as he is no longer detained." We do this on Nov 6 as the parish has a long standing custom of satisfying the last Masses of the Novena on Nov 5.

Please note that Adult Catechism will be held <u>next</u> week (Thurs, Nov 14).

On Fri, Nov 8, a **Requiem Mass with catafalque** will be offered from the deceased members of the FSSP. This, too, is to satisfy the requirements of our Constitutions: "Once a year in each of our houses one Holy Mass with catafalque will be offered for all the deceased members of our Fraternity. On this day, if the circumstances permit, all will recite together at least some part of the Office of the Dead (for instance lauds or vespers)."
