PASTOR'S COLUMN

PASSION SUNDAY

Excerpt from "The Sacramentary" by Ildefonso Schuster

Today begins the fortnight of immediate preparation for Easter, which, in the third century, included a twelve day fast preceding the dawn of the Resurrection. In the sacred Liturgy we can still distinguish the special cycle formed by this holy Passiontide. Whereas during Lent the Church is chiefly preoccupied in the instruction of the catechumens and in the preparation of the penitents for their solemn reconciliation on Holy Thursday, all this during the last fortnight before Easter takes a secondary place. From now onward one thought predominates in the Missal - the thought of the Just One, who realizes the bitter persecution which his enemies are plotting against him. He is innocent, but is so encompassed by the hatred of his adversaries that he has none to defend him. He therefore turns to his heavenly Father, calls him to witness that he is innocent and entreats him not to abandon him in the day of trial.

The liturgical cycle of the Passion begins with the Mass at the Vatican, where Nero crucified the first Vicar of Christ. The passion of Christ dominates, the mourning of his followers, and the continued sacrificial life all those who are called Christians are bound to take.

The ever-growing hate of the Sanhedrin in the build up of the final battle between Christ and the world is dramatically portrayed. The images in the Church are covered, Psalm 42 is removed from the prayers before Mass, and the minor doxology is silenced in the psalmody. Abandonment, hiddenness, a pervasive solitude is the ultimate effect of the Liturgy shorn of these familiar elements. Instead of being our prayer as we prepare for Mass, Psalm 42 forming the Introit becomes narrative....
