PASTOR'S COLUMN

DEATH OF POPE FRANCIS

Pope Francis died on Easter Monday, April 21, at the age of 88. Although Catholics attached to the traditional Mass were frequently - and heartbreakingly - the subject of attack by him, we should recall the noble commandment of Our Lord, who enjoins upon us, even to pray for our enemies, and sets before us his meek and humble heart as our ideal. *De mortuis nil nisi bonum*. For my part, I will remember that he excluded the Fraternity from the effects of *Traditionis Custodes*, and - reportedly - strongly rebuked a Cardinal that tried to expand upon its restrictions over the Latin clergy and faithful in general. We pray that to him is extended that same abundant mercy that we hope to find ourselves when we meet Our Lord for judgment.

A Requiem Mass with catafalque will be offered for the repose of his soul on this Monday evening, and I invite all of the faithful to pray for him. The following is a traditional prayer:

God, Who, in Thine ineffable providence, didst will that Thy servant Francis should be numbered among the high priests, grant, we beseech Thee, that he, who on earth held the place of Thine only-begotten Son, may be joined forevermore to the fellowship of Thy holy pontiffs. Through the same Jesus Christ, Thy Son, Who liveth and reigneth with Thee in the unity of the Holy Ghost, God, world without end. Amen.

PRAYER FOR THE ELECTION OF A SOVEREIGN PONTIFF

from the Missale Romanum

We are graced this week with many saints to whom we ought to specially implore intercession for the gift of a good and holy pope, which we do not deserve on account of our sins, but nevertheless seek confidently from the divine mercy:

- St. Paul of the Cross, on Monday, who was ordained by Pope Benedict XIII and founded his religious order specifically in Rome out of pious devotion to the Holy See;
- St. Peter Martyr, on Tuesday, who was a faithful servant to the Holy See and champion of papal authority;
- St. Catherine of Siena, on Wednesday, who advocated for the end of the scandalous Avignon papacy;
- St. Joseph, on Thursday, the patron and defender of the Church;
- St. Athanasius, on Friday, a lion against heresy and stalwart defender of the Holy See, even in the face of unjust persecution;
- Our Lady, on Saturday, the mother of the Church.

I encourage all to pray daily and - even in light of the Paschal season - to make at least small sacrifices and penances imploring Our Lord to look with mercy upon us. Assistance at Holy Mass this week, if at all possible, would be especially good and pleasing to Our Lord. In any case you might make use of the following prayer, taken from the *Missale Romanum*, as the papal conclave swiftly approaches:

We humbly entreat You, O Lord, that in Your boundless mercy You would grant to the most holy Roman Church a Pontiff who, by his zeal for us, may ever be pleasing to You, and by his good governance may always be honored by Your people for the glory of Your name. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

Response to a dubia (in 2005)

The Apostolic Penitentiary responds to the proposed question - The faithful <u>can</u> seek a plenary indulgence even in the time of a vacant Apostolic See... Even though the Apostolic See is vacant, the conditions of praying for the intention of the Supreme Pontiff are fulfilled (by reciting once the "Our Father" and the "Hail Mary" once, *etc.*), even if he has fulfilled the duty of his life, since the ends of the Pope's intention, <u>the ends for which one must prayundoubtedly the spiritual good of the whole Church persist</u>.
