PRAYER FOR THE ELECTION OF A SOVEREIGN PONTIFF

from the Missale Romanum

From the General House: For our Fraternity in particular, the General House asks that at all public masses from at least May 6th, the vigil of the opening of the upcoming conclave, the following prayer be recited in Latin or the vernacular after the prayers of Leo XIII or at another fitting time for the apostolate.

V. I will raise Me up a faithful priest, who shall do according to My Heart and My soul.

R. And I will build him a faithful house: and he shall walk all day before My Anointed.

We humbly entreat You, O Lord, that in Your boundless mercy You would grant to the most holy Roman Church a Pontiff who, by his zeal for us, may ever be pleasing to You, and by his good governance may always be honored by Your people for the glory of Your name. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever. Amen.

CAMPS SACRED HEART & IMMACULATE HEART

These camps are scheduled for Jun 15 to 21 (Sun to Sat), and Jun 21 to Jun 27 (Sat to Fri), respectively. Camp Sacred Heart is for the boys, whereas Camp Immaculate Heart will be for the girls. Please note the dates on your calendars. The dates are arranged such that families that have both boys and girls attending will be able to pick up the boys on Sat, Jun 21 and at the same time drop off the girls.

Ages for both camps: 10 - 18. A nine year old may be considered for Camp Sacred Heart, space permitting and if accompanied by his father.

Chaplains: Fr. Curtis will lead Camp Sacred Heart; Fr. Franco will lead Camp Immaculate Heart.

Sisters & Seminarians: We will have three seminarians for Camp Sacred Heart and four sisters from the FLM community at Camp Immaculate Heart.

Cost: The camp will be \$250 for the first child in a family, \$200 for the second, \$150 for the third, etc. Scholarships will be available for families for whom the registration fee constitutes a financial burden.


Registration: Available in the parish bookstore and office. Please get your registrations in early to secure a spot on the camp! They will be due on <u>Sun</u>, <u>Jun 1</u>.

P.S. We anticipate at least eighty boys and sixty girls signing up for camp. Outside of some very narrow circumstances (families that used to belong to our parish but have moved away from Sacramento, families that attend Mass elsewhere but are well known to a priest that is well

known to me), I am not taking children from outside the parish.

CAPITAL PROJECTS UPDATE

We are moving towards construction drawings for the restrooms next to the parish hall. The plan will include five stalls for the women's room, two stalls and four urinals for the men's room. As the details (tile, flooring, accessories, etc.) will follow the classroom remodel, we anticipate construction will be more efficient for the parish hall restrooms.
