PASTOR'S COLUMN

PRIESTLY ORDINATIONS

The Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter (FSSP) is ordaining five men (Rev. Messrs. Michael Caughey, Matthew Jagas, Steven Kalinowski, Ronald McCann, John-Francis Sulzen) to the sacred priesthood on Wednesday, May 28. Please keep the *ordinandi* in your prayers.

SPRINKLERS

I have adjusted the sprinkler schedule so that all zones are running more regularly (every day except Monday). Also, the schedule will begin with the southeast zones of the field, working their way northwest hour by hour (more or less), so even if the sprinklers aren't paused for a late night event, people should be able to avoid being unexpectedly soaked. Finally, the picnic area is watered last (at around 6 am), so the dust problem should be alleviated. Further, smaller adjustments may prove to be necessary.

ADULT CATECHISM

The schedule for next year's adult catechism has been worked out. There will be some changes to the format of catechism next year, the principal being that various priests will take certain topics. Another change is that the classes will meet *roughly* every two weeks, instead of more strictly falling on second and fourth Thursdays. As before, the classes meet at 7 pm, in the parish hall, and run about an hour and a half.

I encourage all parishioners to reach out to family members, friends, and co-workers that might be interested in learning about the Catholic faith. An excellent opener is: "Have you ever thought about becoming Catholic?" Or, "I'm going to be attending catechism classes at my parish, would you have any interest in joining me?" Depending on the response, you might assure the person that showing up for the classes – and even registering – does not represent any firm commitment towards becoming Catholic; it is normal for people to attend the classes even if they are merely curious about or investigating the faith.

Our first class is **Thursday**, **August 14 at 7 pm**. Those interested in registering or in the full schedule can contact me by e-mail at **frcurtis@fssp.com**, or they can obtain forms from the parish bookstore. I will try to post the full schedule in next week's bulletin, if possible.
