PASTOR'S COLUMN

KNIGHTS PENITENT

Many of the men in the parish have expressed an interest in forming a confraternity that focuses in the first place on the development of the spiritual life. A preliminary rule has been drawn up by several of them. The group aims to observe a common schedule for prayer and penance, with regular and regional small groups that give opportunity for prayer and accountability. The regional nature of the group accounts for the long distance that many men live from the parish and should provide more flexibility for men to meet at a time that works within their work and family schedules. The group has my endorsement to begin a trial period of one year, that is set to begin on Sept 28 (i.e. the Sunday before the Feast of St. Michael the Arch-angel). More information is available at a booth in the courtyard today. The booth will be held again on Sun, Sept 7, and men are also invited to a meeting on Sun, Sept 14.

SODALITY OF THE BVM

This year the Sodality of the Blessed Virgin Mary will be returning to its roots as a more intentional and focused group of young ladies seeking to deepen and better develop their spiritual lives under the patronage and guidance of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The first meeting of the Sodality (Sat, Sept 6) will be more like a "come and see," at which a parent must be present. Young ladies who wish to join the Sodality should expect to write a hand-written letter expressing their desire to do so. The letter is not an application but simply a manifestation of their intention. Members will commit to attending the meetings, to the obligations and rule of life expressed in the Sodality Handbook, and to a common service project. In addition, they should also anticipate observing good limits regarding the use of social media, in consultation with their parents.

More details and explanation will be given at the first meeting in September. In the meantime, questions may be directed to Amy Rutschow. Young ladies who elect not to participate in the Sodality (or who are unable to do so on account of their schedule) will be welcome and encouraged to assist at the Little Flowers or Rosa Mystica. Those interested in doing so may reach out to Katie Scarry or Hannah Fauci, respectively.

I remind parents that registrations for the groups for all the young ladies of the parish are due next Sun, Aug 17.


