#### SR. KIANA NAVA CLOTHING & RELIGIOUS NAME

In a Solemn Mass in the presence of a Bishop, Sr. Kiana Nava was clothed in the religious habit. She attended Mass in the presence of all of her sisters from the Ava convent. Three other postulants were clothed alongside her; also, two sisters made their first profession. The postulants being clothed began Mass in a wedding dress and veil; at the end of Mass, the bishop clothed them in the habit, belt, scapular, and wimple. Then he gave to them their religious name. Sr. Kiana was named **Sr. Leonie**, after St. Leo the Great.
